


#### NJ TRANSIT TRANSITGRID PROJECT

Technology exists to power the TransitGrid with renewables BUT NJ Transit is proposing to provide energy to the microgrid with a **new natural gas-fired power plant**.


## **INCREASED GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS**

#### A RENEWABLE POWERED ALTERNATIVE




- NJ Transit did not investigate a renewable energy alternative






I am unequivocally opposed to building the North Bergen Power Plant in the Meadowlands and increasing emissions. The project simply doesn't make sense for New Jersey.
